Many coach companies offer a series of pick up points and feed these coaches on to your actual holiday coach. This can mean serious delays and roundabout routes before you even begin your holiday. Do you need the inconvenience?

At Jay & Kay Coach Tours we are proud to offer a **DOOR TO DOOR** taxi service on all of our holidays.

This is a unique service in our local area. **WE** will book a taxi to pick you up from your home and advise you approximatley 7 days before your holiday of the time. This taxi will take you to the coach, sometimes via another address en-route. Your coach will be ready and waiting for you to board as soon as your taxi arrives at Hall Place. When all the other passengers have arrived, the coach departs for your holiday and does not pick up anywhere else. Upon your return from your holiday, a taxi will collect you at Hall Place to take you home.

Occasionally a taxi can be delayed. Please do not panic, the coach will **NOT** depart without you, as our drivers are expecting you.

In the event that your taxi hasn't arrived within **15 MINUTES** of your designated pick up time, please call our office on **01322 522400**. If your call is out of hours, **PLEASE LISTEN TO THE ANSWERPHONE MESSAGE UNTIL THE END**, where a mobile phone number will be given for you to contact.

SUPPLEMENTS EXPLAINED

Some hotels and resorts used by Jay & Kay offer upgraded accommodation and facilities, such as premium rooms and sea views etc

Occasionally, the only option when you book a holiday, may include a forced upgrade which attracts supplements. This is because room quotas have already been allocated to us in advance of your reservation. In these instances, our staff will inform you at the time of booking and make you fully aware of any financial implications. At this stage you have the right to cancel or proceed with the booking.

Numerous properties offer different aspects available to upgrade and whilst every effort is made to include these in this brochure, it is not always possible.

There are many varieties of upgrade facilities at many hotels, it is much easier to ask or be informed at the time of booking as it would take up so much room in the brochure.

Some holidays in this brochure are advertised with NO single supplement, however, this only applies to the single rooms allocated.

Once the allocated rooms have been reserved, we may ask the hotel for extra single rooms on your behalf, but the hotel may then charge a supplement for the additional rooms granted above our initial allocation.

PLEASE NOTE

Some hotels may have split level landings and a few steps to gain access to rooms. Please ask for details when booking.

All holidays are based on half board accommodation unless otherwise stated.

A VERY IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO ALL **CUSTOMERS**

Most of our tour coaches run at full or near full capacity putting limitations on how much space we can accommodate and weight we can carry. These regulations are set by the Government and apply to all Coach Operators and are similar to those of the Airline industry. They are in place to ensure you a safe passage and Jay & Kay are duty bound to comply with them.

More and more of our passengers are travelling with oversize cases and **NOT** adhering to the correct size and weight guidelines as advertised in our terms and conditions section on page 62 in all of our holiday brochures. Furthermore, we are now getting too many customers arriving at the coach without pre notified wheelchairs and walkers, of which we can only carry a maximum of five in total of these items.

Cases must therefore, not be oversized or overweight and all wheelchairs and walkers must be notified at the time of booking. Failure to comply with these conditions may result in refusal to carry oversize or overweight luggage and non booked wheelchairs or walkers. It will be your responsibility to deal with the refused item. Alternatively, if space and weight allow, we will issue a surcharge of £25 per item.

WELLS - SOMERSET

This transfer will cost £20 plus reasonable costs to make the transfer. You will remain responsible for ensuring payment before the balance due date. This is in addition to (and does not affect) the separate liability of the transferee to us.

7. IF YOU NEED TO CANCEL YOUR HOLIDAY

You or any member of your party may cancel your holiday at any time provided it is communicated to us in writing. You must pay cancellation charges to cover costs. Your cancellation will take effect from the date on which we receive your written confirmation of your cancellation. A reduction in room occupancy may increase the charges for the remaining passengers by the application of supplements for low occupancy of rooms. Where bought in supplies, such as ferries, hotel accommodation etc. have been bought in on your behalf, and where the terms and conditions of the supplier are non-refundable, these products will be charged to you at the full retail rate. If this applies, the non-refundable items will be deducted from your

holiday costs and the following scale of charges will be applied to the remainder:

8. ALTERATIONS TO YOUR HOLIDAY BY US

We hope that we will not have to make any change to your holiday but, because our holidays are planned many months in advance, we sometimes do need to make minor changes. We reserve the right to do this at any time. We will let you know about any important changes as soon as possible, including the minimum number of passengers required on the trip. If after booking, and before departure, we make a major change to your holiday, you will have the option of withdrawing from the holiday without penalty or transferring to another holiday without any charge. A major change includes the time of your departure or return time by more than 12 hours, a change in departure point, location of resort or type of hotel, a change in cross channel travel, or specification of the coach. If we tell you about any of these changes after we have confirmed your holiday booking (other than force majeure), you may either:

- accept the new arrangements offered by us; or
- accept a replacement holiday from us of equivalent or similar standard and price (at the date of the change), if we can offer you one; or
- cancel your holiday with us and receive a full refund of all monies.

All holidays operate if the minimum number of participants is met. However, in no case will we cancel your holiday less than 6 weeks before the scheduled departure date, except where you have failed to pay the final balance or because of force majeure (force majeure means an event which we or the suppliers of the services in question could not foresee or avoid and is therefore beyond our control).

9. OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO YOU

We accept responsibility for ensuring the holiday which you book with us is supplied as described in our publicity material and the services offered reach a reasonable standard and if you are in difficulty, we will assist you. We will, however, not be liable if there are any unforeseeable or unavoidable actions of a third party not connected with our travel services, or there were unavoidable or extraordinary circumstances, or the lack of conformity is due to a traveller in the party. We will accordingly pay to our clients such damages as might have been awarded in such circumstances under English Law. In respect of carriage by air, sea, tunnel and rail and the provision of accommodation our liability in all cases will be limited in the manner provided by the relevant international convention.

WHEELCHAIRS

Due to the limited amount of luggage space in each coach, coupled with EU regulations on weight, we reserve the right to refuse carriage for wheelchairs/ walking frames that we have not agreed to carry. Please ensure that you inform us of your intention to bring either at the time of booking. Failure to do so may result in carriage being refused. Please note we do not carry Electric Scooters or Chairs.







LUGGAGE CONSTRAINTS

Due to the limited amount of luggage space in each coach, coupled with EU regulations on weight, we reserve the right to refuse carriage for baggage we deem oversized. The maximum size case we will carry is 66cm (26") long by 51cm (20") high with a maximum weight of 20Kgs. Your baggage may be left behind if you exceed these limits.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

10. IF YOU HAVE A COMPLAINT

If you have a problem during your holiday, please inform your driver or the relevant hotel representative immediately who will endeavour to put things right. If your complaint cannot be completely resolved locally, you must report this to your driver or Jay & Kay representative at your earliest convenience whilst on your holiday. If you fail to follow this simple procedure, we cannot accept responsibility as we have been deprived of the opportunity to investigate and rectify the problem. Should you wish to pursue the complaint further, BCH ABTOT have an Alternative Dispute Resolution scheme and full details are available from them. 11. OUR COACHES

We will always use our own coaches but reserve the right to substitute an alternative vehicle should there be unforeseen circumstances. All seats are allocated at the time of booking which will not be altered unless an alternate vehicle with a different configuration is used.

12. HOTEL FACILITIES

Some hotel facilities and entertainment may be withdrawn for routine maintenance or be subject to seasonal availability and provision of the facilities cannot be guaranteed. Single occupancy of rooms may be subject to a supplementary charge.

13. HEALTH AND SAFETY

In some foreign countries, standards of infrastructure, safety and hygiene may be lower than those to which we are accustomed in the UK. Optional excursions booked and paid for in resort do not form part of your booking. Admission fees to buildings may not be included in the price of the holiday, please check.

If you are refused boarding on the outward journey, we will regard it as a cancellation by you and we will apply cancellation charges. If on your return journey, we have the right to terminate the contract with you.

18. TRAVEL INSURANCE

We strongly advise that you take out personal travel insurance for the trip. The insurance should cover medical and repatriation costs, personal injury, loss of baggage and cancellation charges. If you do not have adequate insurance and require our assistance during your holiday, we reserve the right to reclaim from you any medical repatriation or other expenses which we may incur on your behalf which would otherwise have been met by insurers. You must advise us of the policy number and 24-hour contact number.


